Hampshire street artist Hendog pays us a visit





Upon opening the Lookout on the morning of the 17th November, we discovered that we had been visited overnight by the Hampshire-based street artist known as Hendog.

Dorset Live has spoken to Hendog, who said the artwork of a small child fishing in a fishbowl is titled 'Don't hate the game changer'. To him the piece was a metaphor about not giving up on something. But it's important for people to connect with it in a personal way.

Speaking about why he chose our station at Hengistbury Head, Hendog said, "I go to that location quite often. Everything that I try and do street art wise has a charitable angle either in a direct way or in a different way".

Quoted in an article in the Daily Echo, our Station manager Peter Holway said: "Whilst we appreciate that the artwork added to the lookout overnight by street artist Hendog is really very good, we also need to emphasise that it is graffiti and that we cannot condone the building being used in this manner. "Furthermore, the building isn't owned by the National Coastwatch Institution and we, therefore, have no say on whether the artwork will remain."

This means that we are now officially recognised by HM Coastguard as an integral member of the Maritime Search and Rescue emergency services.


Two assessors – David Crozier and Ian Weston – spent yesterday with our Station managers and committee members and today at the Station with our volunteer Watchkeepers.

HM Coastguard Promoting Use Of NCI For Radio Checks



VHF Channel

Your first call for:

- Radio & AIS checks

From 23rd July 2021, in anticipation of a very busy summer period, HM Coastguard are using VHF Ch16 to promote using NCI on VHF Ch65 for radio checks to considerably reduce the workload of HMCG. The hourly broadcasts state that radio checks can be made using VHF Ch65 between 1000 hrs and 1600 hrs – this being the shortest period any Solent area NCI Station is open. Those of you familiar with NCI Hengistbury Head will know that we are open fro 0800 until 1900 and will happily accept calls during those hours.

Good Morning and Happy Anniversary to us!



Today marks the 3rd anniversary of our opening from the Beach Office at Southbourne on 3rd March 2018.

Unfortunately our Watchkeepers could not actually get to the 'Station' because 'The Beast from the East' had hit, and we had to delay the start of the very first Watch.

Since those humble beginnings our volunteers have: -

Spent more than 26,000 hours on Watch.

Logged approximately 90,000 vessels that have passed through our area of viewing.

Taken approximately 750 VHF Ch65 calls for radio checks/local weather and sea conditions etc., logging Ch65 calls only began in Jan 2020.

Reen involved in 121 incidents.

'Thank You' to Mudeford Sandbank Beach Hut Assn.

We would like to say a very big thank you to Mudeford Sandbank Beach Hut Association (MSBHA) for their very kind, and greatly appreciated, donation.

As with so many other charities, fundraising proved a huge challenge during 2020 and their support will help us to maintain a watch from Barton-on-Sea in the east, through Christchurch and Poole Bays, and 12 miles out to sea round to Bournemouth pier in the west.

This donation will make a real difference to our Station – helping us to continue keeping 'eyes along the coast'.



Effective 6 Jan 2021, HHNCI temporarily operating on single manned basis



Under the latest government restrictions NCI Stations are able to remain operational. However, in order to reduce the risk of COVID transmission as much as possible, with effect from 6th January, we will be operating single manned Watches with a remote phone buddy (unless two Watchkeepers live under the same roof).

We are, of course, pleased to be able to carry on being 'eyes along the coast' but would ask you to bear in mind that it may take a little longer to answer radio checks or phone calls if our Watchkeeper is otherwise engaged in their duties. Please call 999 and ask for the Coastguard if you get into trouble or see anyone else in trouble on the water or coastline.

This means that since the outbreak of the pandemic, our Watchkeepers per shift has reduced from four down to one. By following guidance and remaining positive, we will get through this.
