
an indulgent Italian hamper Raffle tickets will cost £1 each or £5 a strip.

Station Manager, Peter Holway, presented the Mayor with a commemorative NCI pen in recognition of the visit and the fact that in 2017, as a local Ward Councillor, Councillor Lawton had been instrumental in helping the National Coastwatch Institution charity get permission to re-open the Lookout as an NCI Station. 


When our presentation team gave a talk to the Dorset Morris Minor Owners Club on 7th April, they we were delighted to be presented with a cheque for £400.
